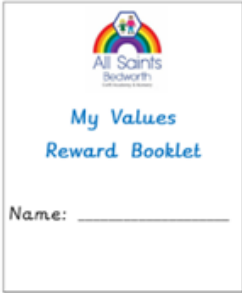


# Rewards

## 'Be the best you can be' tokens



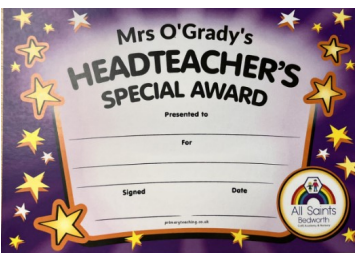
- 🌟 Show our school rules or values in an *amazing* way to earn a token.

# Consequences

## Stage 1: Verbal reminder

Chance to reflect on rules and values

## Stage 2: Verbal warning

Further chance to change behaviour

## Stage 3: Behaviour reflection and consequence discussion

- Complete reflection and consequence sheet with staff member. Decide on appropriate consequence
- Staff will inform my parent / carer:

**Minor physical or aggressive behaviour, including swearing will move a pupil straight to stage 3**

**If a pupil breaks the rules seriously or keeps disrupting learning, staff will follow these next steps:**

## Stage 4: Discussion with senior staff

**Miss Moorhead, Miss Carbonell, Mrs Greenway, Mr Wagstaff, Mrs O'Grady**

Senior staff member will talk to the pupil and decide on the next steps, which might include:

Losing playground time / Loss of pupil leadership role / School based 'community service' – e.g. tidying a classroom / Implement individual reward chart – share with senior staff member daily / Internal suspension – work away from the class for a specified period of time / More formal meeting with parents
