Home reading expectations

The children will be given a book each week and are expected to read every day and have their reading records signed. Children will have lots of opportunities to read for pleasure in the classroom as well as share their best-reads with other children in the classroom through book reviews!

Other homework expectations

Homework will come in a variety of ways:

TT Rockstars (children should complete a minimum of 5 garage and 5 studio sessions); spellings—**10 spellings** will be sent home on **Friday** to learn for a test the **following Friday**; and an **English and Maths** activity each week.

Other class routines

The children come in via the main playground and put their coats and lunchboxes in their assigned lockers. All children should attend school in their full PE uniform on PE days.

To support my learning in Maths, I should

- Have automaticity when recalling multiplication and division facts to 12x12
- Have automaticity when adding single digit numbers- finding ways of adding without the need for fingers!
- Understand the place value of numbers to 1 000 000
- Have a secure understanding of using methods to support calculation
- Understand what a fraction represents and be able to convert/simplify and add and subtract fractions with different denominators
- Understand the place value of decimals to three decimal places

To support my learning in Writing, I should be able to...

- Join letters correctly, ensuring writing remains legible
- Write for a range of purposes and understand the different techniques needed to write for each purpose
- Identify different word classes: verb, adjective, noun, adverb, determiner, preposition, co-ordinating and subordinating conjunction
- Write consistently in the correct tense
- Use different sentence structures- multiclaue sentences using coordinating and subordinating conjunctions, use subordinating conjunctions at the start of sentences and punctuate correctly, embed clauses within sentences for parenthesis, use relative clauses and use adverbials at the start of a sentence
- Use apostrophes for possession and contractions, knowing the difference between the two uses
- Use inverted commas accurately to show speech

To support my learning in Reading, I should be able to...

- Read 90 words within a minute at their current level
- Read a variety of texts- both fiction and non-fiction
- Retrieve information from a variety of texts
- Interpret information about texts
- Work out the meaning of words in context
- Read daily for pleasure and levelled reading book
